The St. Alexius Hospital Mission and ministry are intended to be an extension of the healing Mission of Christ and to reflect the redemptive power and hope made possible by His Suffering, Death and Resurrection.

Trained chaplains encourage freedom of expression by the patient. It could be that in telling a story, having hospital time to reflect, pray, read Scripture or sing, or even simply in being with others who are sick, that new avenues toward healing and wholeness become available.

The Sacraments of Anointing of the Sick and Reconciliation administered by a Catholic priest are arranged by chaplains 6 days per week as requested. Holy Communion is available 7 days per week.

Chaplains are sensitive and supportive of people of all faith traditions as well as those who do not believe.

Chaplains can assist patients and family members with difficult decisions about care as well as with completing Advance Directives for Health Care.


